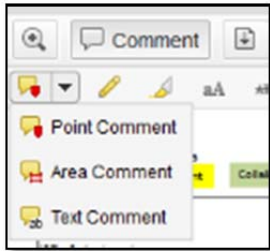

1. Easy marking – use the comment box to add comments:
Point comment – allow you to add a comment at a specific point in the document. It makes a mark on the document and the comment will display on the side.
Area comment – will allow you to draw a box and then your comment will be linked to that box.
Text comment – allows you to write a comment on the document itself. However you have to also click on the Text option and then you can type.
