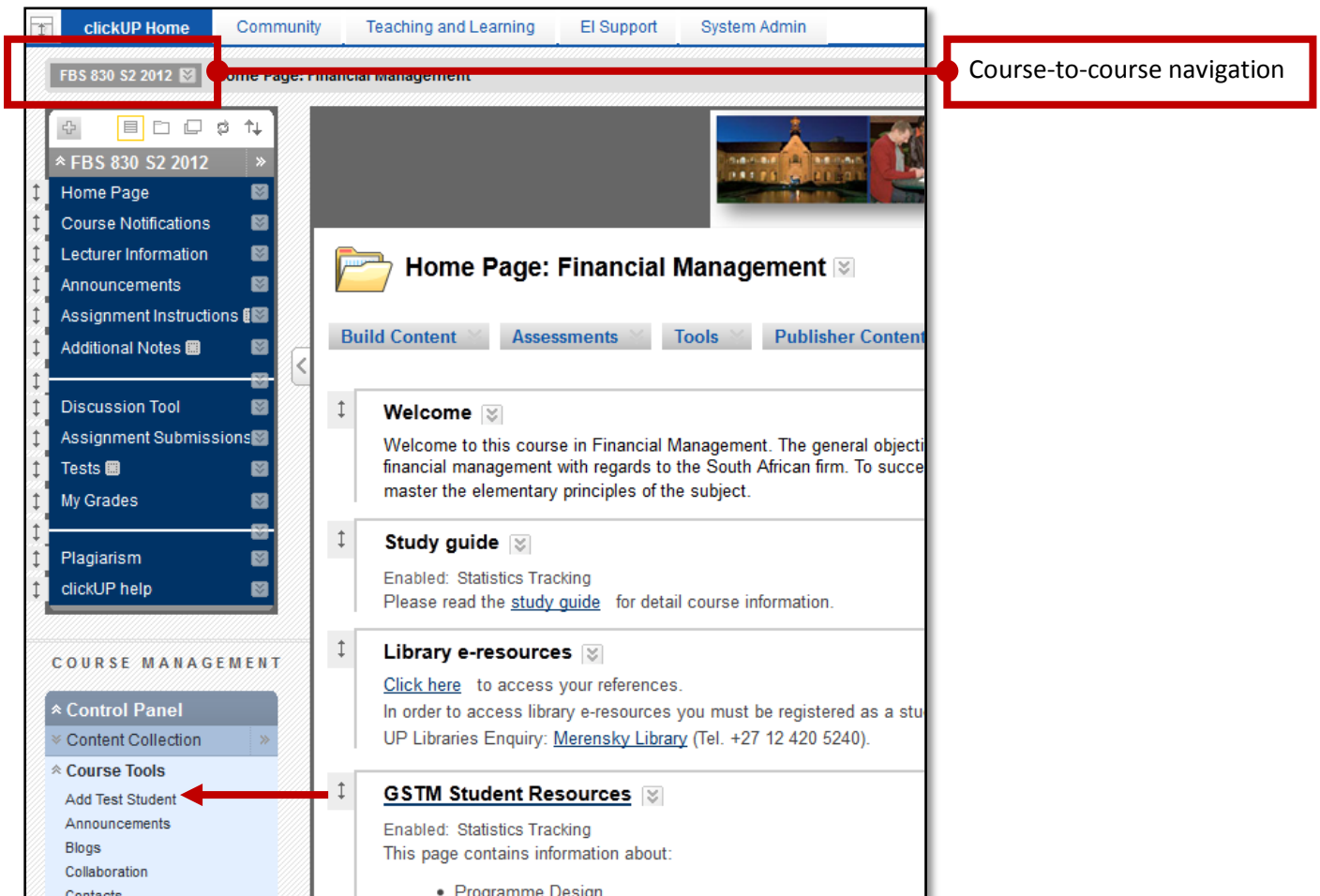




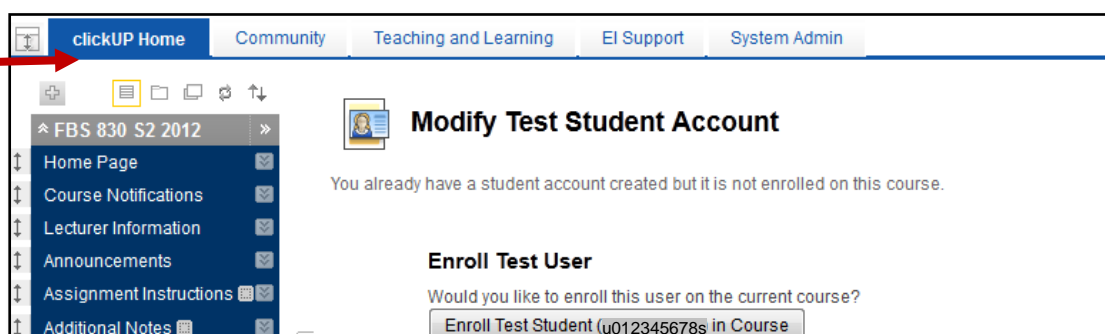
# Why does the course-to-course navigation disappear?

## Question

When I go to a course, the task-based navigation bar appears at the top.



When I click on **Add Test Student**, the task-based navigation disappears ☹️ Why? Therefore I am unable to jump between courses when I am on the Add Test Student tool. The task-based navigation is not where the red arrow indicates on the next screen.



## Answer

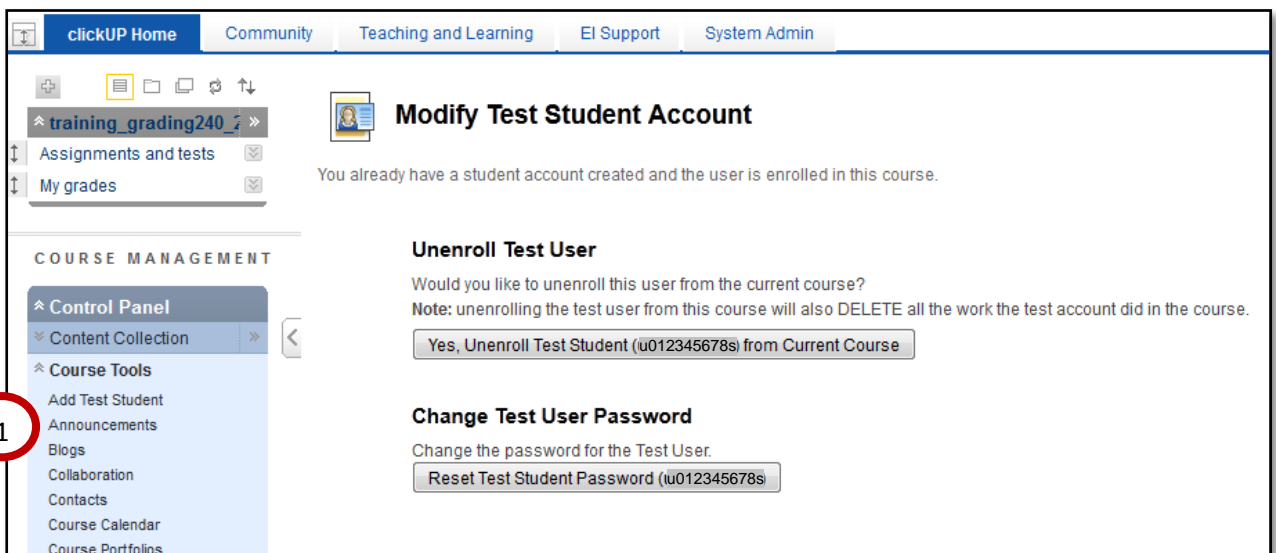
The reason why this happens is because the Add Test Student functionality is a building block (or an add-on) to the clickUP system. So, it is a tool which someone in the Blackboard community created and EI decided to add that tool to our clickUP version so that it will make life easier for our Lecturers.

Other building block tools are:

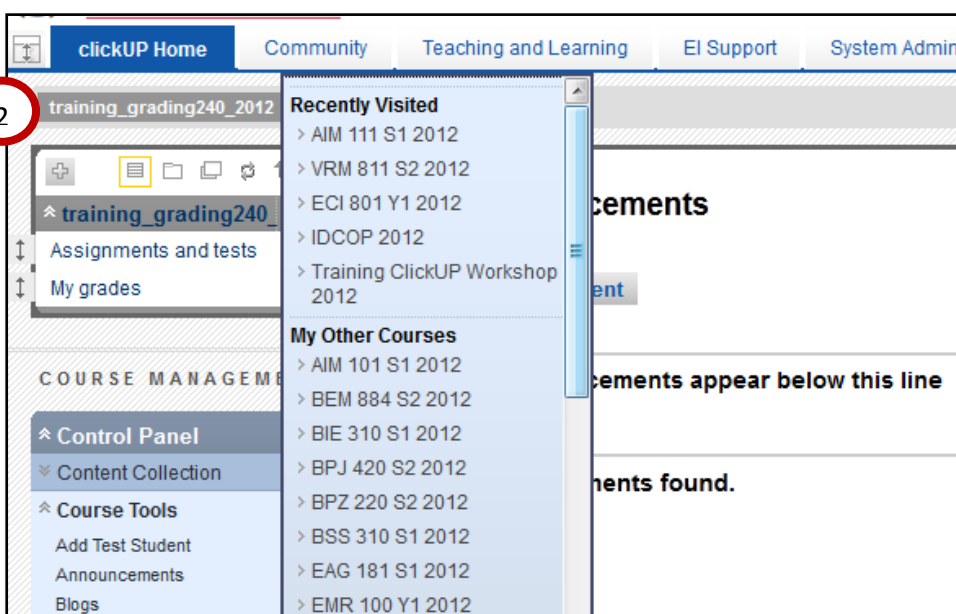
- Grammarly
- GroupsViewer

**Tip:** Therefore if you want to still use the Course-to-Course navigation, take the following steps:

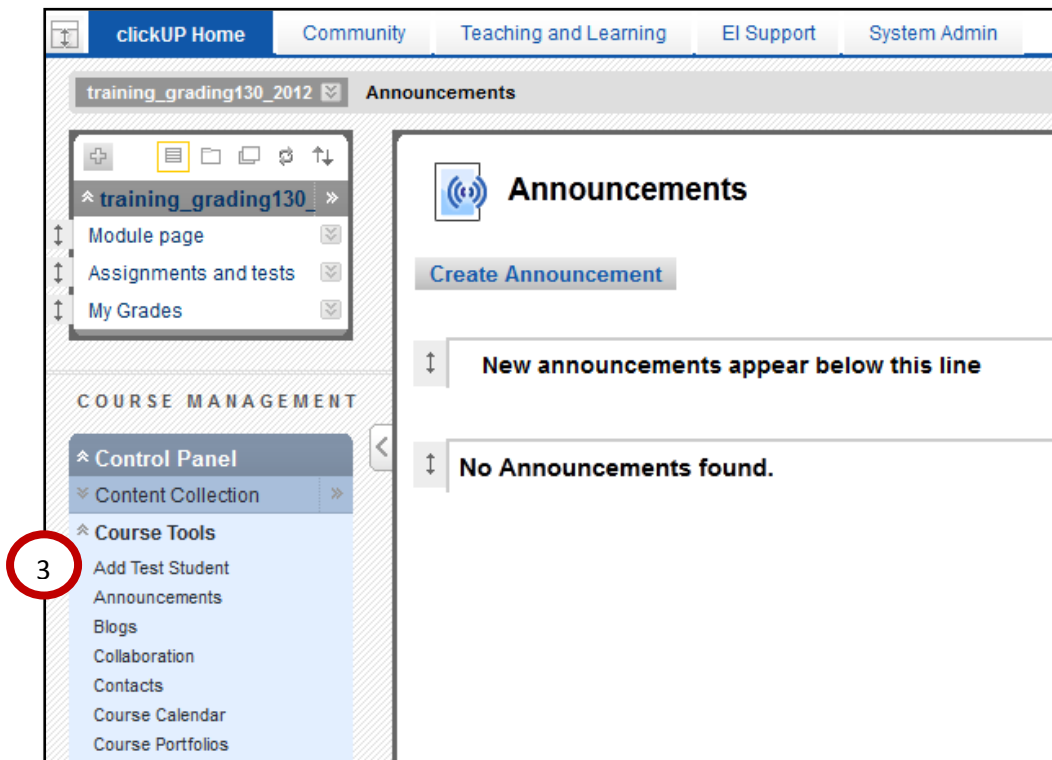
1. From the Add Test Student screen, click on **Announcements**. This will then display the toolbar with the Course-to-Course navigation.



2. Select another course from the list



3. Click on **Add Test Student**.



Take the same steps whenever you want to go to the Grammarly or GroupsViewer tools in another course.
