

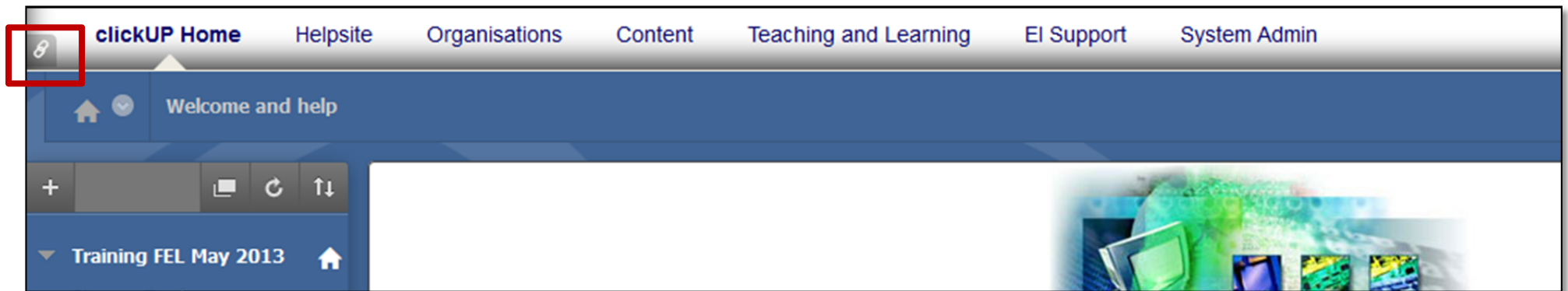
Quick links – New functionality

What is quick links?

This is an innovation that improves BB Learn's navigation experience for all users, but especially sighted keyboard-only users, through page header and landmark aggregation.

The Quick Links tool allows a user to quickly locate any heading or section within any page in the Blackboard Learn application and jump directly to it. This type of navigation efficiency for sighted keyboard only users is not available in any other application anywhere in the industry.

Located in the top left, the Quick Links icon opens a pop-up window that displays the landmark and navigation links on the page. Any available keyboard shortcuts for the page are also displayed.
